FATHERS

Father God establishes "fathers" throughout biblical history!
Sons become both physical and spiritual fathers!
Many are destined to be the "father" of special appointments or nations.
or as with Jesus Christ, the Father of Redemption through the Grace of Salvation
in, by and through Him.

Genesis 5:3 (AMP)

When Adam had lived a hundred and thirty years, he became the father of a son
in his own likeness, according to his image, and named him Seth.

Genesis 5:6 (AMP)

When Seth was a hundred and five years old, he became the father of Enosh.

Genesis 5:9 (AMP)

When Enosh was ninety years old, he became the father of Kenan.

Genesis 5:12 (AMP)

When Kenan was seventy years old, he became the father of Mahalalel.

Genesis 5:15 (AMP)

When Mahalalel was sixty-five years old, he became the father of Jared.

Genesis 5:18 (AMP)

When Jared was a hundred and sixty-two years old, he became the father of Enoch.

Genesis 5:32 (AMP)

After Noah was five hundred years old, he became the father
of Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

Genesis 9:18 (AMP)

The sons of Noah who came out of the ark were Shem and Ham and Japheth.
Ham would become the father of Canaan.

Genesis 10:21 (AMP)

Also to Shem, the father of all the children of Eber [including the Hebrews],
the older brother of Japheth, children were born.

Genesis 11:27 (AMP)

Now these are the records of the descendants of Terah.
Terah was the father of Abram (Abraham), Nahor, and Haran;
and Haran was the father of Lot.

Lot lived in the area of Abraham until God had mightily blessed him with
abundance of family, servants, sheep and goats.

Genesis 19:36 (AMP)

Thus both the daughters of Lot conceived by their father.

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Genesis 19:37 (AMP)

The firstborn gave birth to a son, and named him Moab (from father);
he is the father of the Moabites to this day.

Genesis 19:38 (AMP)

The younger also gave birth to a son and named him Ben-ammi (son of my people);
he is the father of the Ammonites to this day.

Genesis 17:4 (AMP) [God spoke to Abraham]

“As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you,
And [as a result] you shall be the father of many nations.

Genesis 17:5 (AMP)

“No longer shall your name be Abram (exalted father),
But your name shall be Abraham (father of a multitude);
For I will make you the father of many nations.

Genesis 17:20 (AMP) [Father God speaking to Hagar, Sarah's handmaiden]

As for Ishmael, I have heard and listened to you; behold, I will bless him,
and will make him fruitful and will greatly multiply him [through his descendants].
He will be the father of twelve princes (chieftains, sheiks), and I will make him
a great nation.

Genesis 25:19 (AMP) [Isaac the Miracle Son]

Now these are the records of the descendants of Isaac, Abraham's son:
Abraham was the father of Isaac.

Genesis 26:24 (AMP) [The Father God appears to Isaac]

The Lord appeared to him the same night and said,
“I am the God of Abraham your father;
Do not be afraid, for I am with you. I will bless and favor you,
and multiply your descendants, For the sake of My servant Abraham.”

Genesis 35:29 (AMP)

Isaac's spirit departed and he died and was gathered to his people
[who had preceded him in death], an old man full of days (satisfied, fulfilled);
his sons Esau and Jacob buried him [in the cave of Machpelah with his parents
Abraham and Sarah].

1 Chronicles 1:34 (AMP)

Abraham became the father of Isaac. The sons of Isaac: Esau and Israel (Jacob).

Genesis 35:10 (AMP)

Again God said to him, “Your name is Jacob; You shall no longer be called Jacob,
But Israel shall be your name.” So he was called Israel.

[Note: Jacob went down into Egypt a father of 12 sons as a family of 70
and the Israelites emerged 410 years later as a nation of 3 million!]

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Genesis 46:26 (AMP)

All the persons who came with Jacob into Egypt—who were his direct descendants, not counting the wives of [Jacob or] Jacob's sons, were sixty-six persons in all,

Genesis 46:27 (AMP)

and the sons of Joseph, who were born to him in Egypt, were two.

All the persons of the house of Jacob [including Jacob, and Joseph and his sons], who came into Egypt, were seventy.

We have travelled the history of God establishing "fathers" to provide prosperity as He has planned to accomplish His will and reveal the power of His Promises; His Covenants!

The New Covenant opens with the birth of Jesus, Father God's only begotten Son. God's plan of Redemption through reconciliation in His Son, Jesus Christ reveals the "Pattern of the Son" for Father God's Blessing of Increase in all things to those (non-gender) who become sons of God.

Let's keep in mind that Jesus is the Pattern Son whose destiny is to bring many sons into the Kingdom of God! Jesus is the "Father of Redemption." He is the author and founder of Salvation! The source of sons who result in supernatural increase into nations is always the author, founder or the "father" of the blessing of multiplicity!

A superior "seed" must be planted to result in the Blessing of increase!

Hebrews 2:10 [Father God focusing on Jesus the Pattern Son... the father of salvation] For it was fitting for God [that is, an act worthy of His divine nature] that He, for whose sake are all things, and through whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, should make the author and founder of their salvation perfect through suffering [bringing to maturity the human experience necessary for Him to be perfectly equipped for His office as High Priest].

John 1:12 (AMP)

But to as many as did receive and welcome Him, He gave the right [the authority, the privilege] to become children of God, that is, to those who believe in (adhere to, trust in, and rely on) His name—

Ephesians 1:7 (AMP)

In Him we have redemption [that is, our deliverance and salvation] through His blood, [which paid the penalty for our sin and resulted in] the forgiveness and complete pardon of our sin, in accordance with the riches of His grace

1 Corinthians 1:30 (AMP)

But it is from Him that you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God [revealing His plan of salvation], and righteousness [making us acceptable to God], and sanctification [making us holy and setting us apart for God], and redemption [providing our ransom from the penalty for sin],

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The Father of heaven tends, guards and keeps his Son at His right-hand..
extending all power and authority!

Ephesians 2:7 (AMP) [The Redemption Plan of Father God]
[and He did this] so that in the ages to come He might [clearly] show the immeasurable
and unsurpassed riches of His grace in [His] kindness toward us in Christ Jesus
[by providing for our redemption].

Colossians 1:13-14 (AMP) The Incomparable Christ... the Father of our redemption]
13 For He has rescued us and has drawn us to Himself from the dominion of darkness,
and has transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,
14 in whom we have redemption [because of His sacrifice, resulting in] the forgiveness
of our sins [and the cancellation of sins' penalty].
