Heaven's Realm

Personal Insights of Relationship with the Holy Ghost and Proof of Heaven

The wonderful book "God's Promises for Men" sites a scripture that spoke very clearly to me . "And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach and patient." (2 Tim. 2:24)

It is of immense importance that we do not err in our teaching of the Word of God. There have been numerous times when the Spirit of the Lord has taken me into spiritual realms whereby He has revealed His love in a deeper relationship. He has generously exposed His nature of the Fruit and Gifts of the Kingdom of Light in many different ways. Most of these spiritual experiences are specifically "spiritual experiences" and are wonderfully personal to show how to walk in these times of study and search for the Light of Truth, Light of Life and Light of the Holy Spirit. These special visions and encounters (events) are so real they either cause a vibrant energy of awe and joy in uncontrollable laughter (Holy Ghost Joy) or they induce an overwhelming drunkenness that initiates sensations in which my "flesh body" is not in control. My intellectual mind is disengaged and filled with glory of which is difficult to express! Yet once out of the depth of the "event" receive significant understanding and insight to various aspects of the "spirit world" including a "touch" of the nature and character of God, These "event" are given to build a very strong faith and relationship with Him! Just as we are earthly fathers, we relate to our individual sons in various manners. Some of those times are very intimate and are specific only to that specific son. It is most gratifying for in the loss of words to share these special things God reveals Himself to each one separately, yet in His divine plan works to edify the whole Body of Christ.

We are cautioned about teachings and doctrine that are not taught in the Word of God. I want to express that New Age teachings (the concept of a "sterile heaven") is a very hard teaching to receive. "Star travelers of supreme intelligence considered "master guides" are not provable in any of the translations available to the Body of Christ. Angels are "light beings" as presented in the Scriptures. God has given insight to there existence and purposes, none of which substantiates they are "master guides! There is only One Master, that being Jesus Christ, [the only Begotten of the Father as "Son of God!]

Neither are the heavens sterile. This term refers to two types of situations. One is the concept of not capable of reproducing or producing; infertile or unproductive. The other refers to a state of being free from microorganisms, especially those which cause disease.

Through the physical knowledge of gigantic observatories of the cosmos and the languages of mathematics (quantum creative mathematical power) we understand the process of renewal of complete galaxies and reproduction of individual stars. These heavenly structures are "light years" apart from each other.

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[Note: The light-year is a measure of distance, not time. It is the total distance that a beam of light, moving in a straight line, travels in one year. To obtain an idea of the size of a light-year, take the circumference of the earth (24,900 miles), lay it out in a straight line, multiply the length of the line by 7.5 (the corresponding distance is one light-second), then place 31.6 million similar lines end to end. The resulting distance is almost 6 trillion (6,000,000,000,000) miles!]

When we use powerful telescopes to look at distant objects in space, we are actually looking back in time. How can this be? Light travels at a speed of 186,000 miles (or 300,000 km) per second. This seems really fast, but objects in space are so far away that it takes a lot of time for their light to reach us. The farther an object is, the farther in the past we see it.

Our Sun is the closest star to us. It is about 93 million miles away. So, the Sun's light takes about 8.3 minutes to reach us. This means that we always see the Sun as it was about 8.3 minutes ago. The next closest star to us is about 4.3 light-years away.

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So, when we see this star today, we're actually seeing it as it was 4.3 years ago. All of the other stars we can see with our eyes are farther, some even thousands of light-years away. Many of those stars no longer exist. They have undergone the process of renewal by process of the "black hole" regeneration and have a New existence, shape, size and brightness!

There are those who teach dimensional levels of physical and spiritual realms. >1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th< They profess "God" and "Jesus" but are void of the Master Who was crucified for our sins, (rebellious ways toward God) and was resurrected to Life Eternal by God the Holy Spirit! Today, and forevermore, He reigns in earth, the heavens and Heaven which is unseen to the natural mind (unregenerated mind).

2 Corinthians 4:18 AMP)

So we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are unseen; for the things which are visible are temporal [just brief and fleeting], but the things which are invisible are everlasting and imperishable.

All of the Gospel is built upon the God of Hope!

It is the Blessed hope of the Promised Eternal Life that gives the "born-again" strength and vision to endure to the end of this physical realm of earthly existence. It is due to the **Hope** that is laid up for us **in heaven that we walk by faith relying and leaning on the Lord Jesus, the Light of God.**

It is Christ shining in our hearts and minds that gives Hope to others as they observe a difference in our words and actions as we yield the guidance of the Word of God and the Holy Ghost.

Colossians 1:5-6 (AMP)

5 because of the [confident] hope [of experiencing that] which is reserved and waiting for you in heaven. You previously heard of this hope in the message of truth, the gospel [regarding salvation]

6 which has come to you. Indeed, just as in the whole world the gospel is constantly bearing fruit and spreading [by God's power], just as it has been doing among you ever since the day you first heard of it and understood the grace of God in truth [becoming thoroughly and deeply acquainted with it.

If we teach that heaven is sterile, it takes away from the 'blessed hope.' Also, how do we reconcile the scriptures that depict things, people, structure, furniture In the Tabernacle of Moses, feasts and a myriad of events and tangibles as well as intangibles? Let's take a look at the scriptures (in a **literal view**)

(There is also a **spiritual view to each** of these scriptures and entities):

- The Heaven, a created Location: Gen. 1:1; 2:1; Ps. 8:3; 2 Cor 12:1-7; Isa. 14:12-14; 66:1; Rev. 21:2, 10
- Heaven was made for habitation and maintaining life to glorify the Father and receive of His infinite blessings. Isa. 45:18; Ps. 8:3-8; Col.1:15-18; Rev. 4:11
- Heaven now inhabited. 1 Ki. 22:19; 2 Ki. 21:3,5; 23:4-5; 2 Chr. 18:18; Neh. 9:6; Mt.22:30; Eph. 3:15; Col. 1:15-18; Rev. 5:13; 10:6; 12:12; 13:6; 19:1;

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- Heaven a better country. Heb. 11:10-16
- Heaven the highest planet. Eph. 1:21; 4:10; Heb. 7:26
- Heaven a paradise. 2 Cor.12:1-4; Rev. 2:7.
- Heaven God's dwelling place. Dt.26:15-18; 1 Ki. 8:30, 39, 43, 49.
- Heaven an heavenly country. Heb. 11:14-18.
- Heaven a location: In the north part of the universe, in relationship to earth. Isa. 14:12-14; Ps. 75:6
- Heaven above, 1 Ki. 8:23 In the highest part of creation, Job 22:12; LK. 2:14; Eph. 1:21; 4:10
- Heaven Shape is round, Job 22:14; Ps. 19:6 like the earth, Isa. 40:22; Eccl. 1:6
- Heaven has inhabitants, Jer. 33:22; Heb 12:22-23.
- Heaven has mansions, Jn 14:1-3.
- Heaven has a temple, Ps. 11:3; Isa 6:1
- Heaven has a throne, Ps. 11:3; Isa. 6:1; Dan. 7:9-10; Rev. 3:21; 4:2, 4; 22:3.
- Heaven has foundations, 2 Sam. 22:8; Ps. 102-25.
- Heaven has a sanctuary Heb. 8:2; 5:9-11, 23-24.
- Heaven has pillars, Job 26:11
- Heaven has animals, 2 Ki. 2:11; 6:17; Zech. 1:8, 10; 6:1-5; Rev 19:11, 14, 21
- Heaven has stones, Josh 10:11
- Heaven has armies, Dan. 4:35
- Heaven has material things, all invisible things are clearly seen by the things of creation Rom. 1:20; Phil. 2:10.
- Heaven has mortal men living there, Gen 5:24; 2 Ki. 2:1, 11; Zech. 14:11-14; Heb 11:5; Rev. 11:3-11.
- Heaven has books, musical instruments clothing, furniture, chariots, food, Tables, bowls, trumpets, swords, trees, other created beings, fountains of water, a throne, walls, gates, a river, horses.

Also, we observe these three heavens:

- Heaven as clouds, Gen. 1:8-9; Job 26:8; 38:9, 25-34; Ps. 77:17-18; Mt 24:30.
- Heaven as starry space, Gen. 1:14-19; 15:5.
- Heaven the dwelling place of Paradise, 2 Cor.12:1-7; Luke 23:43
2 Corinthians 12:4 Paul apparently uses "Paradise" as an equivalent of the third heaven, the dwelling place of God.

Luke 23:43 (AMP) [Referring to one of the criminals crucified at same time as Jesus.] Jesus said to him, "I assure you and most solemnly say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."

The only scripture reference in this study referring to "dimensions" was the following:

2 Chronicles 3:3 (AMP) Dimensions or Measures of the Temple
Now this is the [measurement of the] foundation which Solomon laid for the house of God: the length in cubits—by the old standard of measure—was sixty cubits (90 ft.), and the width was twenty cubits (30 ft.).
